### Crime Prevention advice

Although our area continues to be a safe place to live, the darker nights are drawing in, so we would like to remind Derbyshire residents to think about home security. The following are some ideas to keep your property safe:

- Keep windows and doors locked and always secured, whether you are in your home or not.
- Keep valuables out of sight.
- Keep your car keys in a secure place, if you have a keyless car, consider purchasing an anti-theft car key bag and keep your car keys in the bag.
- · If you are going out in an evening, set a timer for your lights to come on in your home.
- Make sure your house is visible from the street.
- Consider getting lighting for the outside of your property.
- Consider fitting a burglar alarm, ensuring it is installed properly by a reputable firm and is working, also remember to set your alarm when you are going out.
- Be careful when opening your door to unexpected visitors, prior to opening your door use a window or ring doorbell to see who is outside.
